
# Alpbach Seminar Book 2025: Call for Stories

# **Project Overview:**

- **Theme:** We encourage you to explore themes such as your view on rebuilding Europe, a personal moment of truth, reflections on the seminar, impactful experiences, the implementation of learnings, technology's influence on our lives, and building a bold Europe in a sound world.
- **Format:** Creative or reflective writing (stories, poems, memoir, script, dialogue, etc.), fictional, professional, or academic articles/blog posts.
- Length: 1 to approximately 15 book pages.
- **Language:** Any language (please send drafts in English or German to the editors; final publication in your chosen language).
- **No Visuals:** The book will be primarily text-focused.

### **Editorial Process:**

Start settling your story idea in the first days of your stay in Alpbach. Work on it in the second week after the seminars are over. Polish and deliver your story by September 12th to the editors via WhatsApp. We will review and contact you with any questions; we will not alter your content.

- **Earnings:** There will be no earnings for editors or authors. Potential Amazon revenue will cover costs or be donated.

- **Withdrawal:** You can leave the process at any time. After publishing you can withdraw your story at any time. A new edition will be published without it (approximately 3 weeks processing time).
